## R E S O L U T I O N N O. 71105

## 47TH STREET

RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, California, having in open session on the 26th day of March, 1940, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids for the following work to be done and improvement to be made in said City, to-wit:

All the street work and improvement described in Resolution of Intention No. 70713, adopted by the Council on January 30, 1940, and on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City for the grading, paving and otherwise improving of 47TH STREET, in the City of San Diego, California, within the limits and as particularly described in said Resolution of Intention.

For a particular description of the work reference is hereby made to said Resolution of Intention.

The costs and expenses of said work and improvement are to be assessed upon the district which is more particularly described in said Resolution of Intention.

The said Council determined that serial bonds extending over a period ending nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the fifteenth day of the next October following their date, bearing interest at the rate of six per cent. per annum, shall be issued to represent assessments of twenty-five dollars or more for the expenses of said work and improvement, as provided by the Improvement Act of 1911, and amendments thereto.

For further particulars, reference is hereby made to said Resolution of Intention.

Said Council hereby rejects all of said proposals or bids, except the next herein mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work or improvement to the lowest, regular responsible bidder, to-wit: To V.R. DENNIS, an individual doing business under the firm name and style of V.R. DENNIS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, at the prices named in his bid, for said work, on file in the office of the Clerk of said City of San Diego, to-wit:

Excavation, per cubic yard, - - - - -	\$ 0.40
Embankment, per cubic yard, - - - - -	\$ 0.10
Preparation of subgrade, per square foot, - - - - -	\$ 0.01
Pavement, per square foot, - - - - -	\$ 0.118

6" cast iron water main, with connections, fittings and appurtenances, laid, per lineal foot, - - - - -	\$ 1.25
Fire hydrants, with appurtenances, installed complete, EACH, - - - - -	\$125.00

4" sewer laterals, installed, EACH, - - - - -	\$20.00

## R E S O L U T I O N N O. 71106

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

The report of the committee recommending a lease with Messrs. Wayne W. Daillard, Warren Worcester and Curtis Coleman on the Mission Beach amusement center, to cover all concessions except the plunge, be and it is hereby adopted.
