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STATEMENT ON INCLUSIONARY ORDINANCE

SAN DIEGO – Councilmember Vivian Moreno has issued the following statement regarding the San Diego City Council’s approval today of the proposed inclusionary housing ordinance:

“I was pleased to support the revisions to the city’s inclusionary housing policy today. Requiring that affordable units produced are at 60% area median income will allow the construction of more affordable units.

Thank you to Council President Gomez for bringing forward positive changes and a compromise to this inclusionary policy.

I have one goal- build more housing for San Diegans. We need to get more units built and increase housing supply.”

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Councilmember Vivian Moreno represents the Eighth Council District of the City of San Diego, which includes the communities of Barrio Logan, Egger Highlands, Grant Hill, Logan Heights, Memorial, Nestor, Ocean View Hills, Otay Mesa, San Ysidro, Shelltown, Sherman Heights, Stockton and the Tijuana River Valley. She is the Chair of the Land Use and Housing Committee, Vice Chair of the Committee on the Environment, a member of the Committee on Budget and Government Efficiency, Committee on Infrastructure and the Committee on Public Safety and Livable Neighborhoods.
