Statement on Seditious Language Repeal

SAN DIEGO – Councilmember Vivian Moreno has issued the following statement regarding the San Diego City Council's approval today of the ordinance to repeal San Diego Municipal Code section 56.30 titled Seditious Language – Prohibited.

"I support the repeal of this unconstitutional code section in order to protect free speech, but we need to do more."

- "San Diego Police Officers need to be re-trained so that every officer understands that this is no longer an enforceable law.
- Our City Attorney should work with members of the public who have been victimized by these citations to expunge these tickets from their records and refund any paid fines.
- I also requested that the Public Safety & Livable Neighborhoods
 Committee receive an update from the City Attorney's Office on these efforts."
